# Signet buys piece of telecom company

**Signet Electronic Systems Inc.** bought the telecommunications piece of **Ideacom Technologies Inc.** for an undisclosed sum, the company said Tuesday.

Norwell, Mass.-based Signet bought the voice communications portion and telecommunications staff at the Stratham, N.H.-based Ideacom. Signet said the move will extend its offerings in the New England area.

"In acquiring the telecommunications portion of IDEACOM's business, SIGNET will bring its customers the same dependable, 24-hour service, experienced advice and quality solutions. In addition, those customers will now have access to a vast array of additional integrated services, including video surveillance, access control, intrusion, public address, nurse call and local area networking installations," Bradford S. Caron, executive vice president of Signet, said in a statement.

Signet made a previous acquisition in Rhode Island in 2006, when it purchased Executone.
