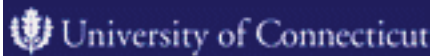

In an effort to increase energy awareness, SIGNET recently participated in National Grid's energy efficiency program, resulting in an on-site audit of its offices and a thorough review of its utility costs. As a result, SIGNET is pleased to report that all lighting fixtures in its corporate offices will be upgraded. The \$30,000 investment, although seemingly costly and somewhat inconvenient to business operations in the short-term, will prove a long-term benefit to both overhead costs and to the environment.

National Grid estimates that SIGNET's participation in these efficiency measures will equate to a reduction of approximately \$6,000 in annual utility costs and a reduction of over 58,000 pounds of greenhouse gases annually. UCONN Campus Adds Technology to Busy Campus Intersections



SIGNET is proud to have been selected by the University of Connecticut's Division of Public and Environmental Safety to implement a video surveillance solution. The University's Police Department has initiated a pilot program to verify the effectiveness of an IP-based video surveillance system using high resolution mega-pixel cameras to be installed at strategic intersections of their campus. The impetus for this new pilot program was an unfortunate accident involving the death of a young woman at one of the intersections, which required six months of investigative work to identify the hit-and-run driver. The driver was eventually prosecuted and is behind bars, but the University is looking forward to the added benefits of a state-of-the-art surveillance system, to aid in the safety and security of everyone at UCONN.

The University of Connecticut Police Department is an internationally accredited law enforcement agency and is a fully functional police agency with the same statutory authority as any municipal police department in the State of Connecticut.
