SIGNET Project Engineer Earns Prestigious Certifications

Vigneau completed the requirements to become both a Certified Electronic Systems Technician (C-EST) and a Certified Technology Specialist – Installation (CTS-I) after completing training and rigorous examinations. Fewer than 200 individuals currently hold either one of these highly respected certificates, according to the trade organizations sponsoring the certification programs.

The C-EST certification, sponsored by the National Systems Contractors Association, requires an applicant have four or more years of experience as a systems technician, systems installer, systems engineer, project manager or estimator. The certification, earned after passing a 100-question written exam and a performance exam, is held by 133 individuals, according to the NSCA.

The CTS-I certification is awarded by InfoComm International, a leading non-profit association serving the professional audio-visual communications industry worldwide. A CTS-I installs and maintains audio-visual systems. It requires at least two years of experience and previous certification as a Certified Technology Specialist. According to InfoComm International, 180 individuals are certified.

Vigneau, a Hingham resident, has been with SIGNET for more than six years.
